| <b>6.1</b>  | <b>Cllr.Penrose</b>   | That this Municipal District would look at the possibility of carrying out essential maintenance of the roadside margins of our local and regional roads in order to prevent narrowing of the roadway as appears to be happening at present due to the lack of 'edging' work being carried out. |
| <b>6.2</b>  | <b>Cllr.Penrose</b>   | That this Municipal District would complete and plough/re-seed the green area in Winetown Park, Rathowen as when works were carried out at this location in putting in a new treatment plant, the restoration of the green area was not completed.  |
| <b>6.3</b>  | <b>Cllr.Dollard</b>   | That Westmeath County Council would provide details, including site locations, of all land banks which it owns in the Mullingar Municipal District Area.  |
