7.1	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would tarmac the road in Carraigmor Estate, Ballynacargy, as this road is broken up and is dangerous for all residents living in this estate.
7.2	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would include in the Estimates some funding to repair footpaths in and around Lynn Heights, as they are a hazard for residents living in this estate.
7.3	Cllr.Duncan	That this Council installs free wi-fi in Mullingar Town Park during the day to encourage more users.
7.4	Cllr.Duncan	That this Council would construct a boat slipway at Ladestown.
7.5	Cllr. Dollard	That Westmeath County Council would carry out much needed repairs to the footpath on the Ashe Road opposite the entrance to Raithin.
7.6	Cllr. Dollard	That Westmeath County Council would eliminate weeds and arrange for the mechanical road sweeper to sweep the road and footpaths at Canal Court OPD complex.
7.7	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District corrects the flooding off Cionn Torc Avenue on to the Community College pitch, at Castlepollard.
7.8	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District re-sets the loose tiles at the Handball Alley in Delvin.
7.9	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to consider using universal pay and display tickets for all same priced car parks, therefore allowing people to use valid tickets in different car parks on any particular day.
7.10	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to eliminate flooding which occurs on wet days under the Old Railway/Greenway Bridge in Ballinea, posing a danger for passing motorists.
7.11	Cllr.Shaw	That this Council would repair/replace the swing and zip line at Killucan Playground.
7.12	Cllr.Shaw	That this Council would remedy the flooding issue at Gillicks Newsagents, Coralstown.
7.13	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to replace yellow boxing on the Green Bridge and that the traffic signalling system would be checked.
7.14	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to cut back trees on roundabout at Van Nelle, Dublin Road, as they are obstructing light No.45.
7.15	Cllr.Clarke	That this Municipal District supports SVDP in its calls on the Commission for Energy Regulation to review its suggested increase of 36% in the Public Service Obligation Levy, which if acted upon will represent a gross increase of €90 per year, and over a staggering 400% increase in 4 years.

7.16	Cllr.Clarke	That this Municipal District recognises and appreciates that our constituents in smaller towns and villages have a right to see democracy at work in their own locale and as such, we commit to holding a minimum 2 meetings a year of the MMD in each of the local election areas, regardless of the availability of a Council owned venue.
7.17	Cllr.McDaniel	That Mullingar Municipal District would take action to solve the flooding problem on Road L1216 Ballinagore to Rahinmore at Hegarty's.
7.18	Cllr.McDaniel	That Mullingar Municipal District would investigate incidents of raw sewage overflowing from (a) manhole close to the River Brosna at Relic Road, Kilbeggan (just off Main St) during heavy rain and (b) gullies causing flooding on two residential properties at Tullamore Road, Kilbeggan, following heavy rain and subsequent blockage of the mains.
7.19	Cllr.D'Arcy	That this Council would encourage developers to create sustainable urban green spaces in their housing developments that offer lasting economic, social, cultural and environmental benefits.
7.20	Cllr.D'Arcy	That the Council would consider running a day at Lough Lene to test the interest and meet with the community who would like to see this becoming a location where people learn to swim.
7.21	Cllr.Wallace	That Mullingar Municipal District calls on the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport to retain the Sports Capital Grant, as this is a vital and major source of funding to many local sporting organisations.
7.22	Cllr.Wallace	That Mullingar Municipal District would carry out a safety audit to assess the need for a pedestrian crossing at Mullingar Community College, as a matter of urgency.
7.23	Cllr.Hill	That this Municipal District would repair Road L5527 leading off the N51 at Addinsown, Delvin.
7.24	Cllr.Hill	That this Municipal District would repair road leading past the GAA pitch at Collinstown.
7.25	Cllr. Whitney	That Mullingar Municipal District would advise if Transport Infrastructure Ireland has indicated if works are planned for the N4 from Ballinalack to Rathowen, as the surface is breaking up in many areas.
7.26	Cllr. Whitney	That Mullingar Municipal District would plan to invest in some radar speed signage for our villages located on busy speed traps, as they seem to be the most effective way to reduce motorists' speed.
