9.1	Cllr.Penrose	That this Municipal District would widen the road between Brian Gavigan's and Donal Gavigan's on the Castletown Geoghegan to Dysart Road at Rathnamuddagh, in the interests of safety.
9.2	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would take immediate steps to surface dress Church Lane, Rathowen, which was badly damaged by flooding earlier in the year.
9.3	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would put in place a traffic calming measure at No.3, Canal Avenue, Mullingar, to improve road safety at this location which serves 11 OPD's, an apartment complex of 8 units for mostly elderly people and a support hostel for former psychiatric patients which houses 7 apartments.
9.4	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would carry out much needed footpath repairs between No's 6 and 7, Ginnell Terrace, following excavations by Irish Water.
9.5	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to take action to alleviate illegal parking in the taxi rank along Church Avenue, which occurs every weekend, preventing taxis from using this rank.
9.6	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to ensure that the public light at the entrance to Cloon Lara is working as soon as possible, in the interests of public safety, as it has been out of action for a significant amount of time.
9.7	Cllr.Davitt	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to examine the camber of the road at Mrs.Marie Reilly's house at Knockmant, The Downs, as it is leading to flooding in this area.
9.8	Cllr.Davitt	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to address the dip in the road at Matty Forde's house at Clonlost, Killucan.
9.9	Cllr.D'Arcy	That Mullingar Municipal District Members support the ISPCA's call for an immediate ban on the use of wild animals in circuses, on animal welfare and ethical grounds, as more and more EU countries have introduced bans on this out of date and cruel practice.
9.10	Cllr.D'Arcy	That to celebrate St.Patrick's Day and the importance that parades have at the heart of our communities, that we recognise the work carried out by voluntary committees in this area and perhaps create a small pin or similar memento for the volunteers involved in the parades around the Mullingar-Coole areas.
9.11	Cllr.McDermott	That Mullingar Municipal District would repair Road No. L5517-30 from Clonapple Cross to Mooretown.

9.12	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District would lay a drain at Anthony McNamee's house to the opposite side of the road at Ranahinch, Streamstown on Road No. L5730.
9.13	Cllr.Duncan	That this Municipal District would request An Garda Siochana to increase the number of foot patrols in the town, particularly around the Town Park and MacDonaldis area.
9.14	Cllr.Duncan	That this Municipal District would install cctv in the Town Park.
9.15	Cllr.Clarke	That this Municipal District shows solidarity with local Tesco workers who are seeking to have their long standing contracts honoured.
9.16	Cllr.Clarke	That this Municipal District calls on the Local Enterprise Office to extend the marketing training to local voluntary and community groups seeking to build their online base.
9.17	Cllr.Shaw	That this Municipal District would set aside funding for a pedestrian crossing at Treacy's Filling Station, Kinnegad, to cater for primary school children.
9.18	Cllr.Shaw	That this Municipal District would restore the cul de sac at Enniscoffey, Gaybrook, which has deteriorated badly in recent years.
9.19	Cllr.Whitney	That Mullingar Municipal District would consider the possibility of putting a continuous white line from the crossroads at Loughnavalley out the Glencarra Road, where appropriate (R389), in the interests of safety.
