6.1	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would pipe the drain that runs down to Russagh Graveyard as this is an ongoing danger to nearby residents, including young children and needs immediate attention due to the present serious health and safety concerns.
6.2	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would investigate the possibility of putting in place a right turning lane on the R392 on the Mullingar side of Shandonagh Bridge (at the entrance to Kiernan's) as a matter of urgent road safety need.
6.3	Cllr.Dollard	That Westmeath Tourism would make a presentation at a future meeting of Mullingar Municipal District which would include amongst other issues plans or proposals it has to enhance the District from a tourism initiative point of view.
6.4	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would carry out much needed road restoration at Greatdown, The Downs, Mullingar at an early date.
6.5	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to take preventative measures to stop illegal dumping on the piece of land directly opposite the entrance to The Moorings.
