8. Notices of Motion

8.1	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would investigate the walkway under the Boardstown Bridge on the northern side, as it has been closed off for the past number of months.
8.2	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would write to TII regarding flashing “Know Your Speed” signs as one enters Rathowen from both the Mullingar side and the Longford side, as traffic is considerably heavy in this area and it would increase the safety of residents and pedestrians in this area.
8.3	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would liaise with Irish Water with a view to having the underground service pipes (asbestos type) upgraded in the context of the Taughmon Group Water Scheme.
8.4	Cllr.Dollard	That in the context of social housing provision, that Mullingar Municipal District would indicate (a) the number of houses acquired by way of purchase and (b) the number of casual vacancies that arose within its own housing stock during 2016.
8.5	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to contact Iarnrod Eireann with a view to closing off the unofficial opening to their property across from the entrance to Newbrook Grove, as this location is being used as a dumping ground and for anti social behaviour.
8.6	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to review road safety at both pedestrian crossings at the immediate sides of the hospital roundabout.
8.7	Cllr.Duncan	That Mullingar Municipal would give a breakdown and timeline of the process whereby members of the public can express their views or concerns in relation to the proposed Mullingar town centre enhancement scheme.
8.8	Cllr.Duncan	That the Municipal District of Mullingar would identify potential sites for the development of a community/sports centre in Mullingar.
8.9	Cllr.McDermott	That Mullingar Municipal District finalises ownership of Fore Coffee Shop at Fore.
8.10	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District produces registration maps from Land Registry to advise who owns what at Fore Coffee Shop.
8.11	Cllr.McDaniel	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to provide lighting and more warning signage at the junction of N52 and L1127-L1122 at Dalystown, in the interests of road safety.
8.12	Cllr.McDaniel	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to convey in writing to AA Roadwatch, that Junction 5 on the M6 Motorway should include reference to Kilbeggan when this exit is mentioned in any broadcast, as at present it is referenced as Exit 5 Tullamore.
8.13	Cllr.D’Arcy	That Mullingar Municipal District would carry out a safety review of the Ardmore Road, specifically related to concerns of residents and taking into consideration ramps, signage and speed limits.
8.14	Cllr.D’Arcy	That this Municipal District would consider setting back the cars from the new mural in Blackhall carpark so that it can be seen by the public.

8.15	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to clarify the position where a main sewer runs behind a number of houses, that it should be classified as a main sewer and therefore maintained by Irish Water.
8.16	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to install a pedestrian crossing mid way on Dominick Street, in the interests of public safety and businesses on the street.
8.17	Cllr.Wallace	That the Municipal District of Mullingar would replace the picnic bench on the R446 just outside Milltownpass at the picnic area.
8.18	Cllr.Wallace	That the Municipal District of Mullingar would consider remedial works to the existing footpath from Manorfield Estate, Kinnegad, where it is extremely narrow.
8.19	Cllr.Clarke	That Mullingar Municipal District works with the executive of Westmeath County Council and the new Cathaoirleach to replace the word "Chairman" outside the Council Chambers to a more gender inclusive term.
8.20	Cllr.Clarke	That Mullingar Municipal District takes on board the valid concerns of the residents of Newtown, Mullingar in relation to line of sight and visibility of oncoming traffic and would install a speed ramp at that location.
8.21	Cllr.Shaw	To call on this Municipal District to work with Killucan Tidy Towns in relation to the enhancement of the "Mass Path" or double ditch that links the villages of Killucan and Rathwire.
8.22	Cllr.Shaw	To call on this Municipal District to investigate the possibility of providing an off-street car park in Kinnegad to cater for daily commuters.
