7.1	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would put in place traffic calming measures to slow down traffic on the Newtown Road, Ballinderry, as car users are speeding on this road and this is a danger to both pedestrians and other road users who use this road. (
7.2	Cllr.Penrose	That Mullingar Municipal District would provide monies under the low cost safety measures to provide a pedestrian crossing at Loughnavalley National School.
7.3	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would vigorously pursue and enact the Derelict Sites Act.
7.4	Cllr.Dollard	That Mullingar Municipal District would include resurfacing of the road that serves O'Connell Terrace, Mullingar in the 2017 Works Programme.
7.5	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to consider upgrading pedestrian safety along the Green Road, considering the increased commercial activity in this area.
7.6	Cllr.Glynn	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to make immediate road safety improvements on the approach to the mini roundabout in Mullingar Business Park outside Expert, in light of the high number of road accidents at this location.
7.7	Cllr.McDaniel	That Mullingar Municipal District would install public lighting between the school and the church at Rahugh.
7.8	Cllr.McDaniel	That Mullingar Municipal District would immediately commence work on outstanding developments at Abbeybrook, Kilbeggan.
7.9	Cllr.Wallace	That Municipal District of Mullingar would consider installing audio visual guides in Belvedere House and Gardens, in order to enhance the visitor experience.
7.10	Cllr.Wallace	That Municipal District of Mullingar would carry out maintenance on Mullingar Town Park with regard to moss on footpaths and the replacement of the fence surrounding the play area, particularly with St.Patrick's Weekend being a showcase weekend for our town.
7.11	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District repairs Road No.L5625 from Gigginstown to Iralco.
7.12	Cllr.McDermott	That this Municipal District would plant a semi mature beech hedge each side of the pelican crossing at Fore School, bounding the private properties.
7.13	Cllr.Shaw	That this Municipal District would repair cul de sac road at Annaskinnan, Killucan close to the level crossing.

7.17	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to advise what plans are in place to clean up chewing gum from the streets and public areas.
7.18	Cllr.Collentine	To call on Mullingar Municipal District to look into the possibility of some disabled parking spaces in carpark located close to businesses in Dominick Place (Dominick Place Roundabout), as there are many businesses in this area and no disabled parking close to these businesses.
7.19	Cllr.Hill	That Mullingar Municipal District would carry out repairs to road leading from Finea Church to Castletown Church, as water ponding outside a number of houses is causing problems for people trying to keep walls cleaned and painted.
7.20	Cllr.Hill	That Mullingar Municipal District would improve surface on road leading from Multyfarnham to Coole at the bend past The Friary as the surface is reported to be very slippery.
