APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

This form should be completed when it is proposed to temporarily close a public road.

Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993 gives powers to a Road Authority to temporarily close a public road for any specific reason including the carrying out of roadworks, holding of road races and other events. It should be noted that this process will take a minimum of one month to allow for advertising of intention to close, considering submissions, advertising decision to close, etc.

An application must be accompanied by:

- a) Detailed map (not hand drawn) showing the location of the proposed road closure and alternative routes clearly marked.
- b) Copy of Public Liability Insurance with a minimum limit of indemnity of €6,500,000.

Please note that the applicant is liable for all advertising costs incurred by the Road Authority associated with the road closure process.

It should be noted that the applicant will be responsible for all traffic control and associated Health and Safety requirement.
