The above declaration must be provided by a person who is resident in Ireland and who wishes to exchange a recognised driving licence for an Irish driving licence. A recognised driving licence is a driving licence issued in a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, or a State declared to be a "recognised State" under the Road Traffic (Licensing of Drivers) Regulations, 1999.

All recognised licences presented for exchange purposes must either be current, **OR**:-

(a) in the case of licences issued by a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, have expired within the ten year period preceding the date of licence exchange application,

OR

(b) in the case of licences issued by a "recognised State" other than a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, have expired within the twelve month period preceding the date of licence exchange application.
