

Minutes of Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District held on Monday, 14th November 2016, at 2.00pm in the Council Chambers, Áras an Chontae, Mullingar.

Item 1 : *Miontuairisci*

- (i) On the proposal of Cllr. Glynn, seconded by Cllr. Penrose, the Minutes of October Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District held at 2.00pm on Monday, 10th October, 2016 in the Council Chambers, Áras an Chontae, Mullingar were unanimously approved.

Matters arising:

Cllr. Hill asked if there was an update on cutting of trees adjacent to the Council offices in Castlepollard. The Director advised Cllr. Hill that this matter is being attended to.

Item 2 : *To consider Chief Executive's report and General Municipal Allocation (GMA) issued under Section 102 (4A)(a) of the Local Government Act 2001 (as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014).*

Mr. Jimmy Dalton, Director of Finance, presented to the Members the report on the General Municipal Allocation for 2017 which would form part of the overall Budget of Westmeath County Council to be considered by the Members of the County Council at their meeting on 28th November, 2016. He explained how the GMA is calculated and answered questions from the Members. The Members unanimously accepted the Chief Executive's report and General Municipal Allocation (GMA) issued under Section 102 (4A)(a) of the Local Government Act 2001 (as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014).

Item 3 : Approval of Community Grants

The Members had been circulated with information in relation to Residents Association Grants, Christmas Lighting – LED Fund and Community Action Scheme grants.

Members noted that the grants have decreased in 2016 and they asked that consideration be given to increasing these community grants in 2017.

On the proposal of Cllr.Glynn, seconded by Cllr.McDermott, the Members unanimously approved the Residents Association Grants, the Christmas Lighting – LED Fund and the Community Action Scheme grants as circulated to them.

Item 4 : Date for December Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District

The Members agreed the date of Monday 19th December, 2016 at 2pm as the date for the December 2016 Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District. Ms.Kitty Foyle advised the Members that the last date for receipt of Motions & Questions for the December Meeting is 4pm on 7th December, 2016. Ms.Foyle also drew Members attention to the date scheduled for the January 2017 Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District, as contained in the Schedule to be considered under Item No. 5. In this regard, she advised that the last date for receipt of Motions & Questions for the January 2017 Meeting of Mullingar Municipal District falls within the Christmas holiday period, i.e. Wednesday 28th December, 2016. This was noted by Members.

Item 5 : Schedule of Meetings for 2017

On the proposal of Cllr.McDermott, seconded by Cllr. D’Arcy, the Members unanimously agreed the Schedule of Meetings of Mullingar Municipal District for 2017, as circulated to them.

Item 6 : To note date for Civic Reception

The Members noted and agreed the date of Monday, 21st November, 2016 at 5.30pm in The Executive Lounge, Aras an Chontae, Mullingar for the holding of Civic Reception in respect of Mullingar Youth Project. The Director asked if as many Members as possible could try and attend this Civic Reception to lend their support to this local youth group.

Item 7 : Report on Litter Bins in Mullingar Municipal District

Mr.Murty Hanly presented a report to the Members on a survey which had been conducted of the location and number of all litter bins within the Mullingar Municipal District Areas. Mr.Hanly advised that the survey had indicated that some bins are located in unsuitable locations and may be moved, other areas have a proliferation of litter bins and some may be removed. Equally, he stated some areas require the provision of additional bins and all of these matters are under consideration by the Municipal District.

Cllr.Hill stated that any changes should be discussed first with the local community groups and he highlighted Castlepollard in particular.

The Director advised the Members that the exercise which was carried out was extremely useful and was not intended as a means of removing or increasing the number of bins within the District. However he agreed that certain areas will be re-examined in the context of the number of litter bins required. He stated that the review will be followed up throughout the year.

Furthermore, the Director advised that if Members wish to discuss a particular location with the Municipal District staff, they are welcome to do that. Equally, he stated that full engagement will be had with tidy towns and local groups before any changes are made with regard to bins.
