The Director advised that as the Council did not advance the initial expression of interest, the data referred to by Cllr. Clarke is not available to Westmeath County Council.

Item 2 : *Municipal District of Mullingar Roads Estimates 2017.*

On the proposal of Cllr. Glynn, seconded by Cllr. McDermott, the Roads Estimates for 2017 in respect of Municipal District of Mullingar, and as circulated, were unanimously agreed.

Item 2A : To consider Draft Litter Management Plan 2017-2019 in respect of Mullingar Municipal District.

Mr. Leo Buckley, Executive Engineer, presented the Draft Litter Management Plan 2017-2019 to the Members, which had also been circulated to the Members. He stated that under the Local Government Reform Act 2014, it is a reserved function of the Council to adopt a Litter Management Plan and Litter Bye-Laws and that this is to be the role of the Municipal District Members. He went on to advise that the strategic aim of the Plan is to improve, protect and promote our environment, in the interests of present and future generations. The Plan sets out commitments for managing litter, while working in partnership with all citizens of the county.

The Members welcomed the Plan and were glad to see that measures are included in the Draft Plan to bring members of the public who are found guilty of allowing their dog to foul the footpath or any public area to court and to prosecute such persons for these offences.

Under the public consultation process, submissions have been invited from the Gardai, the Chamber of Commerce, Public Participation Network, the HSE and from waste collectors.

Item 3 : To note Festival and Events funding.

Members were circulated with a list of committees and groups that had been awarded funding under Phase 1 of the Festival and Events Grant Scheme 2017. These were noted.

Item 4 : To note update on funding for Housing Grants 2017.

Members noted letter dated 28th February, 2017 from the Department of Housing, Planning, Community and Local Government in relation to Housing Adaptation Grant Schemes and Housing Grants for Older People.
