Re: Naming of Roads in Athlone for 1916 Proclamation Signatories

Dear Mayor and Members,

At the February Meeting of Athlone Municipal District it was resolved that “the 5 roads listed hereunder be called after 5 leaders of the 1916 Rising not already commemorated in the Town”

- Road from Burgess Park Roundabout (bottom of John Broderick St) to Civic Amenity Centre – Ceannt Road (Bóthar Ceannt)
- Road from Burgess Park Roundabout (bottom of John Broderick St) to Ankers Bower Roundabout – MacDiarmada Road (Bóthar MacDiarmada)
- Road from Clonbrusk Resource Centre (Coosan Rd/Abbey Rd) to Clonbrusk Roundabout (Arcadia Retail Park) – Clarke Road (Bóthar Ó Cléirigh)
- Road from Clonbrusk Roundabout (Arcadia Retail Park) to Arcadia Roundabout (Coosan Point Rd) – MacDonagh Road (Bóthar MacDonncha)
- Road from Clonbrusk Roundabout (Arcadia Retail Park) to Roundabout at New 2 Mile (adjacent to SDS) – Plunkett Road (Bóthar Pluincéid)

A public notice was placed in the local press on 2nd March and written submissions were invited in relation to this proposal; these were to be submitted before the 25th March 2016.

No submissions were received and I now recommend that these roads be so named and that road names signs be erected in due course.
